

Clean energy fair part of Sun Day

Meadville will host a clean energy fair Sunday as part of Sun Day, a nationwide day of action celebrating solar and other forms of renewable energy.

The event will be held at The Arc Community Greenspace, 967 Market St., from 1 to 3 p.m.

Sun Day Meadville will highlight clean energy usage in our community and identify opportunities for additional installations for what is now the most economical forms of energy available, organizers said.

Local solar installation sites currently include those at Allegheny College, Common Roots homes, Unitarian Universalist Church, The Arc Community Greenspace, and other residential and commercial locations around Meadville.

Through hundreds of local events like this one, Sun Day aims to demonstrate public support for renewable energy and build momentum for policies that address climate change.

At the event, representatives from local institutions and individuals will be available to share their experiences, serving as a resource for those considering moving to clean energy.

Mayor Jamie Kinder will present a proclamation making Sunday “Sun Day” in Meadville, and attendees can help create a map of where clean energy is being used in the community. Information also will be available about legislation to allow for community energy generation such as solar.

Free children's books about solar energy will be distributed while supplies last.
