The Arc Community Greenspace



Since 2019 The Arc of Crawford County and the City of Meadville have been transforming a blighted city lot into an art-filled, public space that fosters inclusion while modeling innovations in stormwater design, applications for solar-power and best practices for community-focused public art and placemaking.

The site features an ADA accessible walkway, three solar-powered umbrella tables, and a performance stage with benches and shade umbrellas. The walkway leads visitors through the site, encompassing the performance stage and highlighting a historic, local stream. The site serves as a venue for community events and provides greenspace adjacent to Meadville's downtown. A series of community-informed murals frames the site, addressing slum and blight from adjacent buildings.

The performance stage will provide space for theatre, live music, and other community-organized events in support of arts, culture, and wellness, and inclusive communities.



Solar-powered umbrella tables, installed in December 2021, provide public seating and shelter from the sun. The tables also power phone charging stations and augment free public WIFI.
