

# The Arc to hold July 4 celebration at Community Greenspace

The Arc of Crawford County’s inaugural July 4 Community Celebration will take place Friday from 3:30 to 8 p.m. in The Arc Community Greenspace, 967 Market St.

The free celebration features an acoustic show and community sing-a-long with Brookville musician Mike Zaffuto, creator and founder of the Rock-N-Roll Pet Store Kids Show. His set will be followed by Naughty Bears, a local favorite that is more than just a drum-and-guitar duo. Bound by love, rhythm, and a shared devotion to the noisy heart of American music, Naughty Bears features Ian Carbone and Taylor Hinton, who blend indie grit, blues swagger and Americana soul.

Live, improvisational, lifesize puppet performances will occur throughout the event.

Guests can try on a puppet costume and take a selfie in it. Volunteers will be available to assist with try-ons and photos.

Yard games and chalk art opportunities also will be available. Cousins Maine Lobster food truck will arrive around 2:30 and serve until the end of the event, organizers said.
